Codi ymwybyddiaeth o leihau gwastraff yn y cartref, mewn busnesau ac ysgolion

GWEITHGAREDDAU CYMUNEDOL

Byddwn yn cefnogi a hwyluso datblygiad cymuned fywiog sy'n gallu rhoi cyfle i gymryd rhan mewn amrywiaeth o weithgareddau corfforol a gweithgareddau eraill – cymuned lle mae pobl o bob oed yn gallu diddanu neu gael eu diddanu yn yr iaith o'u dewis hwy.

Darparu gwasanaethau cynghori yn yr iaith Gymraeg e.e. yng Nghanolfan

ECONOMY AND EMPLOYMENT

We would like to see a sustainable local economy distinct to 'Bro Ddyfi' based on Bro Ddyfi's culture, resources, products and environmental assets. Visitors should have an excellent experience of finding out about, staying in and enjoying Bro Ddyfi, including sustainable outdoor activities. Local enterprises, including social businesses, should get help to become established and grow, and farmers could become engaged in a wide range of economic activities. Personalised business and careers support services should be accessible locally.

Issues under discussion by this Theme Group include:

Providing work for young people to enable them to stay in the area

More affordable childcare

Developing new business opportunities

HOUSING

Evidence from the Housing Needs Assessment we carried out supports the need for more affordable housing. Identified needs include starter homes, homes for young people and for expanding families, with these being available to rent, purchase or for shared ownership.

Issues being worked on by this Theme Group include:

Developing something on the serviced plots at Llanwrin and Dolfach and at other identified sites

Encouraging affordable self-build projects

Reducing heating costs and dampness in houses

TRANSPORT AND COMMUNICATION

Following the Transport Needs Assessment that we carried out, we fully appreciate the need to offer attractive options for cyclists and walkers that can help to bring communities together. There should be a flexible and integrated transport system, supported by local people, including community transport solutions. Road and rail infrastructure should meet local needs and Broadband should be available for all.

Issues being explored by the Dyfi Transport Forum include:

Shared use foot and cycle paths, especially at Penegoes

Encouraging people to walk & cycle

An hourly rail service from Aberystwyth to Shrewsbury

Public or Community Transport for villages: first those to the NE and SE of Machynlleth and expanding to villages south of Lanbrynmair

EDUCATION AND TRAINING

We foresee a community where barriers to learning are overcome, the learning needs of young people and children are met, and where training supports the future strategy for employment and the economy. The outcome of the ELWa Pathfinder process will be hugely influential, but you have already identified the following issues:

Childcare facilities for young parents wishing to access training

Training for 'trades' e.g. plumbers and electricians

Ysgol Bro Ddyfi as a resource for the community

Sufficient Welsh medium teaching assistants in schools

COUNTRYSIDE AND ENVIRONMENT

The community should be enabled to treat its "wastes" as resources and helped to reduce its impact on the local and global environment.

Issues raised include:

More local production of food and wood, to reduce transport

Raising awareness of reducing waste at home, in businesses and in schools

COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES

We will support and encourage the development of an active community that is able to offer participation in a variety of physical and other activities – a community where people of all ages can entertain or be entertained in the language of their choice.

Issues include:

A bigger and better building for Machynlleth Children's Project

A full-time Youth Worker for Dyfi Valley

More Welsh language activities for young people

A full all-weather sports pitch – possibly a joint project between Ysgol Bro Ddyfi, Machynlleth Rugby Club, and Machynlleth Football Club.

Somewhere for young people between 10 – 18 years to go in the evenings, especially in the winter

HEALTH AND COMMUNITY WELLBEING

Bro Ddyfi will become an even safer and more caring community, where the Welsh language and culture are widely used and valued. There will be accessible and responsive health provision for all, together with friendly, informal advice and information on health and lifestyle matters

Desired actions include:

Encourage mixing and communication between people of differing backgrounds

Maintain the Community Hospital in Machynlleth

Continue community based health & lifestyle advice services

Provision of Welsh language advice services e.g. at Bro Ddyfi Advice Centre
